RISERVA DI FIZZANO CHIANTI CLASSICO GRAN SELEZIONE

Italo Zingarelli, highly-acclaimed Italian film producer best known for his classic spaghetti westerns, purchased the Macie estate in Castellina in Chianti in 1973 and embarked on a career as one of Chianti Classico's more unlikely wine producers.

In 1989, Sergio, Italo's youngest son, with wife Daniela at his side, was appointed company President. Rocca delle Macie now encompasses more than 600 hectares in total, across the company's six estates, with 200 hectares under vine and 80 hectares of olive groves. Thanks to the Zingarelli family's dedication and passion, Rocca delle Macie has become one of Tuscany's leading wine estates.

Riserva di Fizzano Chianti Classico Gran Selezione is produced with grapes grown in one of the family's most prized vineyards. Purchased in 1984, the Fizzano estate is comprised of 35 hectares of land rich in limestone and some sand, principally with south-west exposure, an ideal position for a slow and regular ripening of grapes.

Riserva di Fizzano is the ideal expression of Sangiovese with a touch of Merlot (also grown on the estate). Elegant and complex, but still pleasantly approachable, Riserva di Fizzano Gran Selezione is a wonderful representation of the land and the people who work it. The newly designed label features the vineyard plots where the grapes for Riserva di Fizzano Gran Selezione are grown.

PRODUCTION TECHNIQUES

After fermentation most of the wine matures in 35hl French oak barrels, while a small amount is aged in 225-liter barriques. After the blending the wine rest in the bottle for another year.

DESCRIPTION:

Color: Intense Ruby-Red
Aroma: Intense with hints of wild berries and well-balanced spice.
Taste: Warm with ripe red fruit aromas and a long finish.

PAIRING: Complements red meat dishes, roasts, game and aged cheeses.
