



## COL D'ORCIA POGGIO AL VENTO BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO RISERVA

*Col d'Orcia is the feted producer of one of Italy's most revered red wines: Brunello di Montalcino. Situated near the medieval hilltop village of Montalcino in Tuscany's Siena province, the estate has a rich winemaking history that dates back to the 1700s. In the hands of the Cinzano family since 1973, Col d'Orcia is owned by Count Francesco Marone Cinzano, who oversees day-to-day operations.*

*Winemaking at Col d'Orcia is entrusted to chief enologist Antonino Trachida.*

### PRODUCTION TECHNIQUES

Grape bunches are rigorously selected during hand-harvesting. Fermentation takes place in steel tanks at controlled temperatures below 30°C. After 20 days the wine is transferred to Slavonian and French oak casks to age for a period of four years, followed by further refinement in the bottle for 24 months prior to release.

### DESCRIPTION

**Color:** Deep ruby red with light garnet hues  
**Aroma:** Intense and multifaceted; fruit forward, with hints of licorice, mushrooms and chocolate developing to add further complexity  
**Taste:** Full-bodied, well-structured and powerful at first, leading into a soft, caressing and lingering aftertaste
